2 Tridents	The majority of materials used to build the tridents were provided by the props department. Free of Charge. However, 2 pool cues were hired. Only 1 pool cue was returned as the other was snapped in half. Also, 2 pieces of conduit were used in a later build of the tridents. The conduit was given by the Technical Stage Manager from the scene dock.	'The Royal Conservatoire of Scotland' props store. Located in 'Speirs Lock Studios.' 'The Royal Conservatoire' scene dock. Located within the main building.	Airboard, wire, 2 pool cues, paper mash'e and paint were used to create the tridents. By the use of a template, 4 pieces of airboard were cut into the pitch fork shapes. Wire was sandwiched inbetween the airbaord shapes. The shapes were then glued together. The pool cues/conduit were inserted into the airboard. Paper mash'e was placed over the tridents before being painted black, red and gold.	The tridents were used by Carlo the Clown and Luigi during a fight scene. Due to the first pair of pool cues breaking, I created two more tridents using conduit.
